



We have permission, thanks to Joe's efforts at General Motors, and we will begin with this issue reprinting stories we think were and still are of interest to old and new Corvette owners. By the way, the Club recently became the proud owner of an absolutely complete mint set of "Corvette News" magazines from Volume 1, No. 1, 1957 through March/April, 1972. These volumes were purchased from Dr. Waters of Bloomington, Minn. We have been attempting to purchase a complete set for seven years and finally found one.

THE STORY OF A HOT CORVETTE

Hot Corvette - Beware - Some of you members may have "hot" Corvettes, that is, go fast Corvettes that are really hot, but I'll bet we had one of the hottest 1954 6-cylinder Corvettes going last week at the Westside Auto Body Shop here in Fresno, Calif. Our Corvette was parked to the rear of the shop, 50 feet from the building. While inside the paint shop an employee of the shop decided to pour gasoline into the carburetor of a pick-up truck he could not start. Well, he got it started all right, when it backfired it shot flame out of the carburetor and the whole truck "started" not just running but burning. Also within three minutes, the entire paint shop was engulfed in flames and burned to the ground within twenty minutes. Our 1954 Corvette parked 50 feet away got so hot the driver's side sort of melted and burned - the complete drive train had just been restored, \$1,500 invested in restoration at that time. The body on the left side would cost too much to repair so will put the complete drive train with what's left of the body for sale for \$1,000.00. The moral of the story is if you ever decide to pour gasoline into a carburetor to start an engine and I've done it to many 1954 Corvettes to help start them, get an extra body standing by with a good fire extinguisher because I've heard of three Corvettes lost this same way because of no fire extinguisher available.

JUST WANT TO KNOW WHERE THEY ARE

Corvette Hunt - by Grant D. Ross, Jr., 647 Pine St., Deerfield, Ill. 60015. I do not believe I've heard of anyone going to the research and pains that Grant Ross, 146A, has gone to to try to locate his two vintage Corvettes he previously owned and since sold. He has written hundreds of letters and spent hundreds of hours and dollars researching through Motor Vehicle Departments in Illinois and surrounding states. He writes he has uncovered hundreds of 1956-57 Corvettes in the Motor Vehicle Department files and that a too often mistake made in indentifying serial numbers is people substitute numbers 3, 5, or 8 for the letter "S" for St. Louis in the cars serial numbers. This means that the computer will pass over the card number if the latter mistake had been made. If anyone is interested in his method of research which is quite thorough and too many serial numbers to print here, write to Grant. By the way he is looking for the following two Vintage Corvettes he once E54S002618 and E55S001452. proudly owned: Hope someone someplace, somewhere knows of the whereabouts of these two cars.

The questionnaires made interesting reading and I thought I'd pass on some of the statistics. 15 questionnaires were sent and 13 were received. One has since moved to another region and will not be included in the following figures.

We have 18 regular members and 3 associates. These figures include spouses, which means nine married couples and three otherwise. As near as can be determined, our age group spans forty years with one member purchasing his '54 in 1955. Arizona claims six V.C.C.A. members, Colorado has 11 including our three associates, and New Mexico is home for four.






