

This car is unique in several respects: It is supercharged (which was not factory installed but dealer installed). It has a flat supercharged script (which is exactly like the original flat Chevrolet script), on the car's front as well as the trunk lid. The car has wire wheels, which are very similar to the special ones on Preston Tucker's personal car. There is a special airfilter for the supercharged built into the apron of the body under the hood. The car once owned by Ed Thiebaud of Fresno, Calif., President of Vintage Corvette Club of America. It was also owned by Lynn Dowdy of Janesville, Wisc. As far as Fred knows he is fourth owner of the car. Fred also owns a 1954 Corvette E54S003984 which is also 100% complete, and fully restored.


